Draft Recommendation by ICCAT on Senegal's Bigeye Tuna Payback Plan <u>and Utilisation of Underharvest</u>

(Document submitted by Senegal)

RECOGNIZING that 2,700.77 t of bigeye tuna catches were taken by Senegal in 2020;

RECOGNISING an overharvest of bigeye tuna in excess of its limit of 1,323 t for 2020;

RECOGNISING the underharvests of bigeye tuna by Senegal from 2021 and 2022:

DESIRING to maintain the objectives of the multi-annual conservation and management programme for tropical tunas;

NOTING that Senegal <u>undertakes</u> to payback the overharvest of bigeye tuna and to comply with ICCAT conservation and management measures;

THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION FOR THE CONSERVATION OF ATLANTIC TUNAS (ICCAT) RECOMMENDS THAT:

- 1. The total negative balance for 2020 of 1,377.77 t shall be paid back, at a rate of 137.77 t per year, from 2023 to 2032 (inclusive).
- 2. Senegal shall ensure full compliance with this plan and avoid any further overharvest in the future, notwithstanding provisions in force.
- 3. Senegal is authorised by the Commission to utilise, in 2025 and 2026, its underharvest of 621 t bigeye tuna from 2021.
