SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE NAMIBIAN FLAG VESSEL HALIFAX/ FROM THE IUU VESSELS LIST

With regards to Rec (18-08) under paragraph 6 on removal of vessel from IUU list, let me clarify the situation for these two vessels in the following points:

As background, please note the following:

The Namibian flag vessel Halifax Previous Name (Mario 1 1) was bought from Senegalese company in 2020 and is originally from Senegal (Dakar), and this vessel didn't enter into the fishing campaign since 2020. Furthermore, the vessel was registered in Senegal registration record of vessels and also on ICCAT record.

This vessel was en route to the Port of Walvis Bay in October 2020, Namibia to perform dry-docking and a crew change. The Covid pandemic and the ensuing disaster management protocols adopted by the Republic of Namibia resulted in the closure of the Port of Walvis Bay due to the high rate of Covid positive Infections in this area. This resulted in the vessel calling the Port of Luderitz, where a Namibian company took an interest in the vessel and discussed the owner 's details with the relevant agent.

The Namibian company made an offer to the owners, who were struggling to repatriate the crew and a myriad of other problems, then decided to sell the vessel to this Namibian company. The company has spent the last 10 months refitting this vessel, overhaul and maintenance and bringing its condition up to the Namibian Standard. The vessel has now undergone dry-docking, stability and inclination tests, safety survey, engine overhaul, and has been accepted on the Namibian Register and is wholly owned by a Namibian Company.

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The previous owners have no linkages with the vessel and will not be receiving fish from the vessel. The vessel has been converted in order to be used in the bait boat as well as tuna long line sector in Namibia.

Namibia is extremely proud of this achievement and now have a 1003 Namibian Flag vessel. We intend to sell the fish locally and abroad and we humbly ask for your assistance in this matter.

Therefore, we kindly requested the removal of the Namibian Flag F/V Halifax from the IUU Vessels List.
