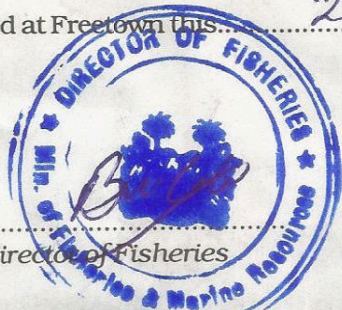
ROYALTY

3. The license is subject to the following conditions.

- I. The Fisheries Management and Development Act 1994 and the Regulations and Amendments thereto.
- II. Prohibited from fishing within the Yawri Bay and other Marine Protected Areas.
- III. Prohibited from fishing within the Inshore Exclusion Zone (IEZ) 5-10 nautical miles offshore.
- IV. Submission of daily radio catch report to the radio room of the Ministry.
- V. A VMS transponder installed on board your vessel must be functional throughout the fishing trip.
- VI. To meet the landing obligation:
 - i. Fin fish.....%
 - ii. Shell fish.....%
- VII. The holder shall comply with and ensure that the vessel is used in conformity with the provisions of the Fisheries Management and Development Act, 1994 and any regulations made thereunder.
