Monitoring, control, and surveillance measures required by the flag CPC and coastal State involved (Max. 1000 characters)

Before Access is granted to a foreign flagged vessel to land their catch in Suriname, we first check whether these vessels meets all the requirements regarding the ICCAT conservation and management measures and our own national requirements. According to Suriname national legislation all foreign flagged vessels must land their fish only at the designated port which is called the port of Cevahas N.V. All fishing vessels, authorized to fish for tuna and tuna-like species in the ICCAT Convention area are required to install satellite-based Vessel Monitoring System (VMS).

Monitoring, control, and surveillance measures required by the flag CPC and coastal State involved (Max. 1000 characters)

Licensing scheme of Suriname obligates the master of each vessels to submit landing declaration forms at the end of each trip to the Fisheries Department of the ministry of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries. These forms includes for example: quantities of landing by species, catch area, catch period, discards, etc. The Panamanian flagged vessels remain under the control of Panama and the catches are being reported by Panama to the Commission as their own catch.

Summary of Activities (Max. 1000 characters)

Suriname has no written access agreement with Panama, however we allow Panamanian flagged vessels to fish in waters under Surinamese jurisdiction for species managed by ICCAT through our national licensing scheme and also allow these vessels to land their catch from high seas under the Panamanian fishing license in Suriname taking into account all the ICCAT requirements.
