SUBJECT: AMBASSADORS WEBINAR ON NORTHERN ATLANTIC SWORDFISH MSE (SWO-N MSE)
(online, 4 October 2024)

The ongoing process in ICCAT to develop a management strategy evaluation (MSE) framework for northern Atlantic swordfish (SWO-N) requires dissemination of this process to fishery managers and other stakeholders. The swordfish Ambassadors programme is an initiative started in 2023 with the goal of fostering dialogue with managers in advance of Intersessional Meeting of Panel 4.

As part of the SWO-N MSE communication team, SWO-N MSE Ambassadors will serve as language-specific contacts for informal webinars to describe the SWO-N MSE process to date. These webinars will function as an educational ICCAT side event, and will not be a forum for the Commission to provide formal feedback to the SCRS.

On behalf of the SCRS Chair, I should like to inform you that the next Ambassadors webinar on SWO-N MSE will be held online on **4 October 2024**. The purpose of this webinar will be to inform upon progress in 2024 on candidate management procedure (CMP) development, further elucidation of the tradeoff space and CMP performance.

Accreditation by CPC or as an accredited observer will be required for participation and questions will be asked on an individual basis. In order to organize the webinar in advance of the sessions, in particular, regarding the number of participants, you are kindly requested to send to the ICCAT Secretariat a list of delegates who will participate by **27 September 2024**. Any late submission of the official delegation may cause delay in providing access to participants to the webinar and to the related documents. Participants must also register by **27 September 2024**, using the [online registration form](#) which will be available shortly on our [meetings webpage](#).

The webinar will run in the three ICCAT official languages and participants will be allowed to attend the most appropriate session in each case.
