Málaga

Málaga is a city in the province of Málaga in Andalusia, Spain, integrated in the "Costa del Sol".



It is the second largest city in Andalusia and the gateway to the Costa del Sol. Its historic old town has narrow streets and squares, parish churches and lively bars. It has historic places such as the Alcazaba (one of the largest Arab fortresses in Andalusia) and the Gibralfaro Castle (with a beautiful view of the entire city). Nearby from that is the Roman Theatre and the historic centre, with lovely streets for a stroll or a "tapas" break in the various bars and restaurants in the area. Other interesting attractions in the historic area are the Atarazana market, the Cathedral of Malaga, the Picasso Museum, the Carmen Thyssen Museum, the Pompidou Centre, among others. On the famous Larios street, in the historic centre, you can find the main clothing, cosmetics and telephone shops, as well as bars and restaurants.





Málaga Fair

The Fiestas Patronales commemorate the capture of the city by the Catholic Monarchs on August 19, 1487. The fair is held in August and pays homage to the patron saint of Malaga, the Virgen de la Victoria.

There are horse-drawn carriage displays, flamenco singing and dancing, and guaranteed fun in the booths at the Fairgrounds and Calle Larios.





Flamenco

The cultural baggage brought by the gypsy people from their pilgrimage from India in the 15th century converges with the sounds of the different cultures that coincided in Andalusia at that time, giving rise to flamenco, a musical genre that dates back to the 18th century, whose main facets are singing, guitar playing and dancing.

In November 2021, UNESCO declared it as an Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

Verdiales

The Verdiales are a festive manifestation of ancient and peasant origin. Since 2009 the Fiesta de Verdiales is in the process of being declared an Asset of Cultural Interest with the category Activity of Ethnological Interest in several municipalities in the province of Malaga.
