Special Meeting Participation Fund¹

In 2020 the Commission adopted the *Recommendation by ICCAT Amending the Recommendation 14-14 on the Establishment of a Meeting Participation Fund for Developing ICCAT Contracting Parties* (Rec. 20-09) which substitutes and repeals Rec. 14-14 in its entirety.

Recommendation 20-09 establishes a Meeting Participation Fund (MPF) to support representatives of those ICCAT Contracting Parties which are developing States for the purpose of attending and/or contributing to the work of the Commission and other subsidiary bodies. This fund was initially provisioned with \notin 60,000.00 from the Working Capital Fund.

The new Recommendation differs from the previous one in that some minimum criteria must be met in order to control costs and minimize the administrative burdens. These minimum criteria are as follows: when a developing Contracting Party sends more than six official delegates to a Commission meeting or more than four to a subsidiary body meeting using its own resources, it will not be entitled to receive financial support from the MPF; in addition, the delegates must travel in the least expensive economy class or another that is more economical, and the flight itinerary must be defined at least 30 days in advance of the meeting.

This fund was financed in 2024 with an allocation of \notin 250,000.00 charged to Chapter 13b) of the ICCAT budget, as approved by the Commission in 2023.

To these funds, the carryover of financial year 2023 must be added, which amounted to \notin 308,692.94. Therefore, the available amount in 2024 has been \notin 558,692.94.

It should be noted that the carryover from financial year 2023 included a voluntary contribution from the European Union through the European Union Fund for Capacity Building. This contribution was made under a contract which terminated in July 2024 and is pending settlement.

In 2024, 126 trips have been organised and 30 CPCs have benefitted.

For 2025, this fund will have a carryover from 2024 of \notin 117,017.12 and the settlement of the contract entered into with the European Union in 2022, which is estimated to be \notin 90,000.00. Assuming that there is the same number of requests as in 2024 for participation in 2025 meetings, and therefore, the same expense will be incurred (\notin 441,675.82), it is estimated that for 2025 it will be necessary to allocate to this fund at least \notin 250,000.00, to reach a balance of \notin 457,017.12. However, if this trend continues, the amount under this heading will need to be increased for the following years, as otherwise it will not be possible to cover all the expenses.
